All matches to be played over 9 ends. Each bowler has four woods per end. First named player to bowl black, players to toss coin to decide who bowls first. Matches up to the Semi final will be timed. A whistle will sound to start each session and then again after 30 minutes. A new end may not start once the whistle has blown a second time. An end is deemed to have started when jack has been placed.

Each player will play against the other players within their group. The group winners and three best runner ups will advance to the quarter-final. Positions to be decided by most points, then shot difference, then most shots for and finally most ends won (in all group games). The teams in groups of five, will be awarded an 11-4 bye (average group game score from last year.) An extra end will be played in the KO stages if a match is drawn. The grey highlighted matches allow the players who have byes to play if they wish to do so, the scores from these games will not count towards final group positions.

Refreshments will be available to purchase on the day. Please arrive at 8.45am to help set out the equipment, and also please all stay to the end of the tournament to support those in the knockout stages and to help put the equipment away at the end of the day.
