Group 1

A tough assignment has been handed to Christine Gee (playing in her first county competition) and Chris Boakes who have been drawn in a group with four players who play as number 3 or skip in our county team (Amy Missing, Matt Thurley, Stuart Mcneil and Rebecca Hearn). There are no former winners in this group. Rebecca is still looking to claim her maiden county singles title to complete her set.

Group 2

This looks to be a competitive group containing five current county players in David Danby, Harry Wilson, Steve Lee, Andy Cobbold & Dave Smith. Mark Trim is the other player in this group and is continuing to improve as he plays more games at this level. Dave (1992) and David (2003 and 2012) have both won the county singles before.

Group 3

Chrissy has been handed a tough draw as she looks to continue to gain experience at this level and will be confident of holding her own. The other four players in this group are all regular county bowlers and have all won county titles in the past. It is just Jack (2016) and Craig (1993, 2004, 2007, 2010, 2014, 2015, 2018 & 2022) that have previous success in the singles.

Group 4

Another competitive looking group, with all five players current members of the county squad and will all be confident of performing well on the day.

Emma has already won the county fours this season. Gary is in good form and has had some impressive singles results in recent years. James has had a very good season at county level and will be looking to bring that form on the day. Lisa has been beaten in the final of the last two county competitions (triples and pairs) and will be looking to go one better this time. Pete (2005, 2019, 2024 & 2025) is the only player in the group that has won the singles previously and will be looking to retain his title.

Group 5

Another group containing five county bowlers. Carole has had a good season, establishing herself in the county team, she will be looking to have a good day and progress to the knockout stages. Marilyn, like Rebecca, is looking to claim her maiden county singles title to complete her set. Lauryn, like Carole, has played her way into the county team. She has already won a county title this season (triples) and got to the knockout stages in the pairs. Dan is another that has played his way into the county team this season. He was a runner up in the fours earlier in the season and will be looking to progress to the knockouts. Neil (2011, 2020) is the only former winner in this group, was runner up in the triples, semi finalist in the pairs and will be keen to win his third county title and qualify for the Champion of Champions events.
